It is hereby stipulated by and between the Petitioner _____, and the Respondent _____, through their respective counsel, as follows:

That the dissolution of the marriage and the termination of the marital status in the within action be bifurcated from all remaining issues. The parties expressly consent to the entry of a judgment of dissolution of marriage as to status only with marital status terminated immediately upon the filing of said judgment. 3. To move to vacate or set aside the judgment if this matter is heard as a default or uncontested proceeding.
